Talk with your partner -- decide together how to stay safe.



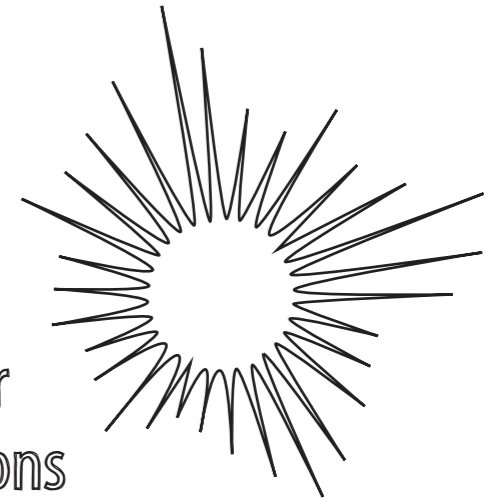
